


# PRIORITY 1:


Increase percentage of pregnant women in the antenatal care in the first trimester =>75%

## Decrease infant mortality -10/1000




PAST 5 YEARS AVERAGE OF INFANT MORTALITY RATE IS = 19.6

To improve the nutritional status of the MCH population



Percent pregnant women in prenatal clinic with low hemoglobin

UP TO 2 YRS. OLD




PAST 5 YEARS AVERAGE PERCENTAGE OF IMMUNIZATION COVERAGE IS = 57.5

Rate per 1,000 women aged 15 through 19 years with a reported case of Chlamydia





PAST 5 YEARS AVERAGE RATE OF CHLAMYDIA IS = 11.0

# PRIORITY 6:

Rate of birth (per 1,000) for teenagers aged 15 through 17 years





PAST 5 YEARS AVERAGE RATE OF TEEN PREGNANCY IS = 22.4

# PRIORITY 7:

Third grade children who have received protective sealants on at least one permanent




PAST 5 YEARS AVERAGE PERCENTAGE FOR ORAL HEALTH IS = 37.9

# PRIORITY 8:
