- Bachelor's Degree in Social Work

- Duties: Does case management, follow-up with doctor's orders in the Special Kids Clinic; maintains and updates CSHCN Registry; conducts Genetics and Shriners Clinics; conducts and participates in telemedicine conferences; does home visits; coordinates off-island travel to Shriners Hospital in Honolulu; attends multidisciplinary meetings

- Has been with the MCH Program since 2004
- Duties: Responsible for MCH budget, does requisitions and submits financial reports
- Parent representative for CSHCN Program

- Has been with DPHSS for 18 years/BFHNS
- Duties: Sees MCH clients at Central Public Health
